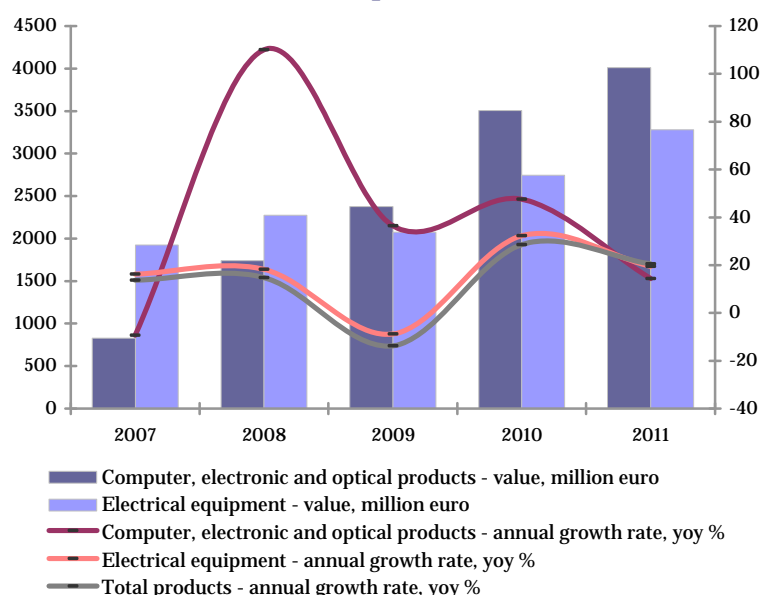

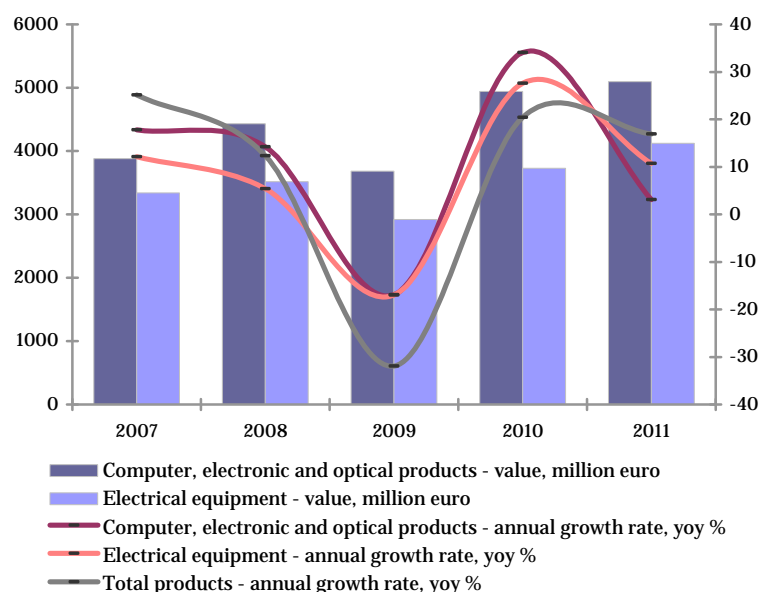

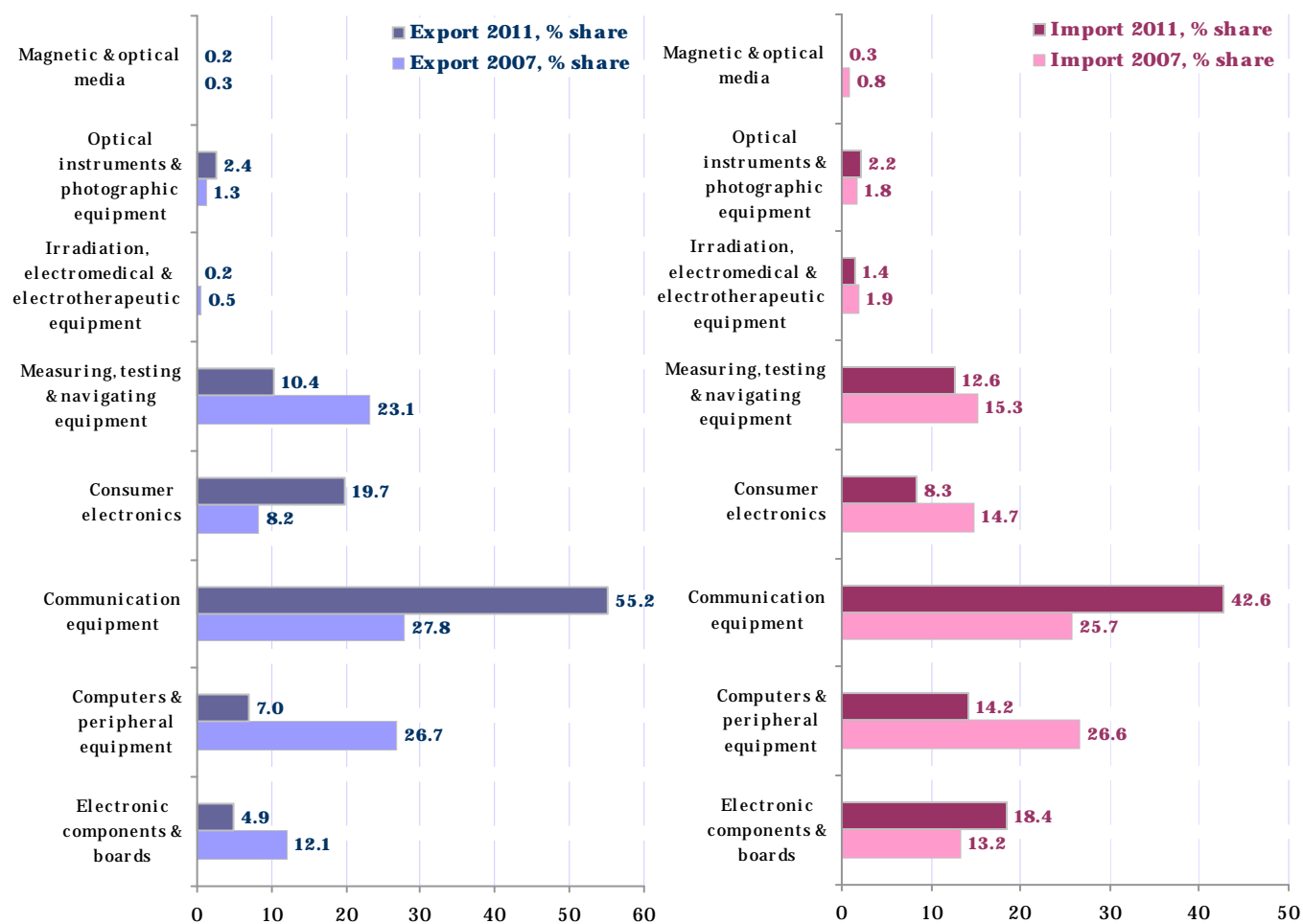

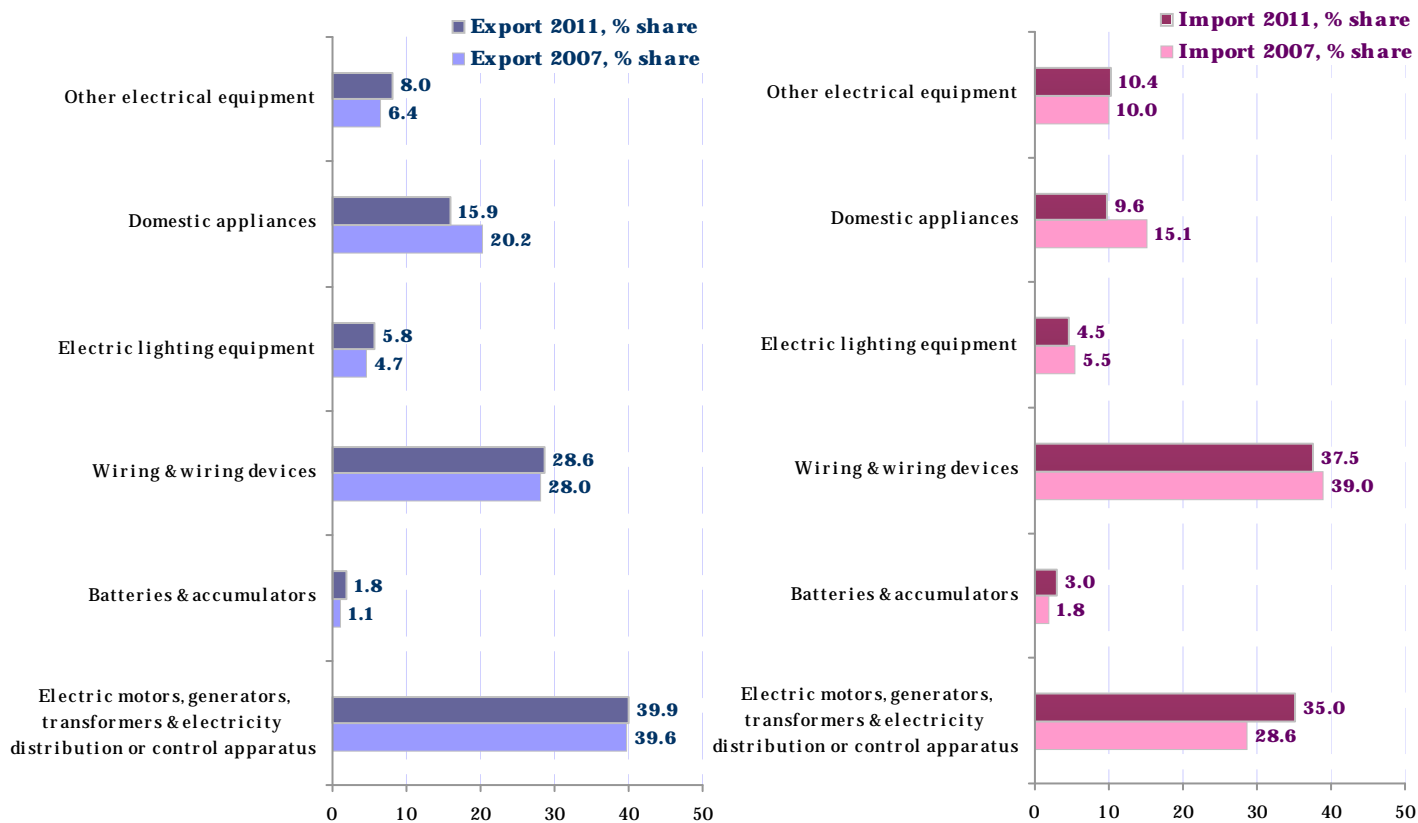
Computer, electronic and optical products: Trade breakdown by main product groups, 2007-2011

Electrical equipment: Trade breakdown by main product groups, 2007-2011

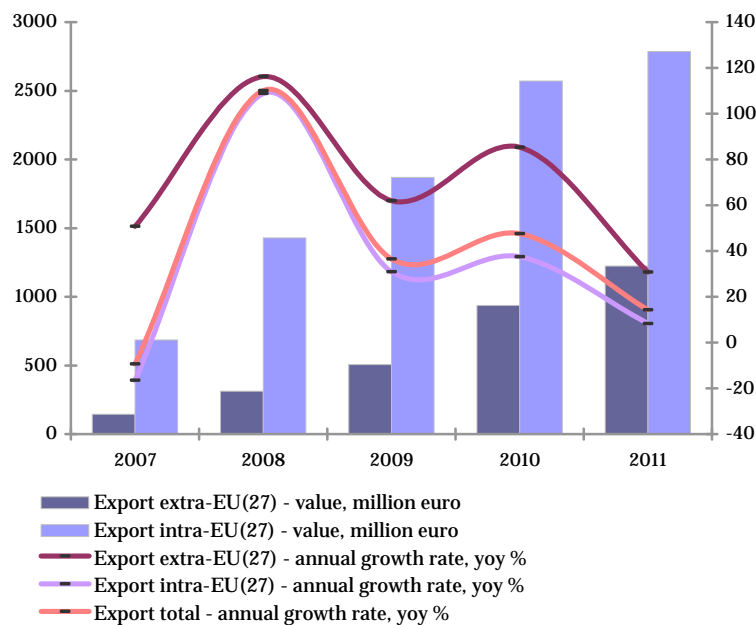

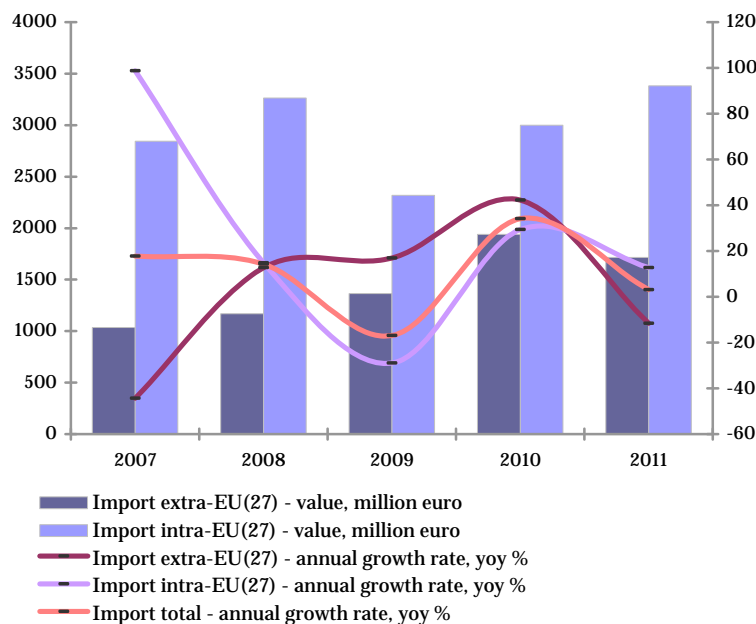

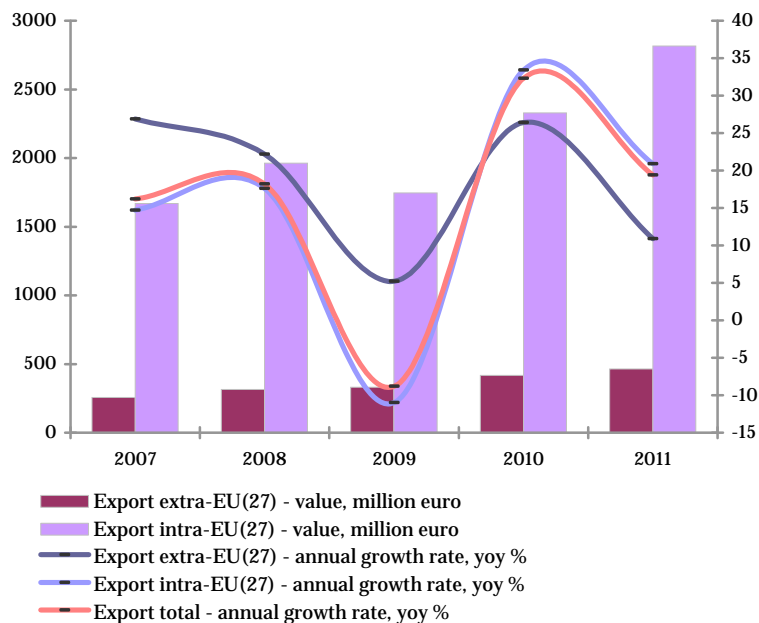
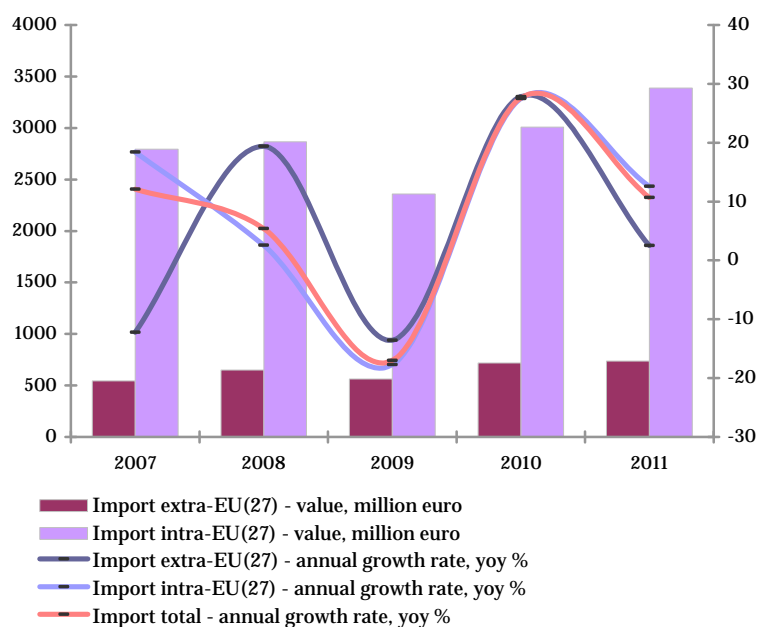
